Well done Tilly Owens, Lincs Hammer County Champ with a PB 18.82 and Lauren Owens, Pole Vault County Champ 2.2m. Tilly also 3rd in the 1500m and 2nd in the high jump and Lauren 4th in th eshot 5.87m. Congratulations to Amber Owens Lincs County champ and new PB 10:46.5 in the 3000m!

Nottinghamshire

Nottinghamshire's event is run across two days with Derbyshire with the venue alternating between stadiums in Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire. This year was the turn of Notts to host at Harvey Hadden on **Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th May**.

A great 800m run by Ben with a new PB of 2.11.60 to win bronze as a first year u15. Anna Smith county champ in the u15 girls 1500m and 800m - an impressive result considering the 1500m win came after running and winning both heat and final of 800m on the Saturday where she ran ES qualifying time of 2.15.86 - a new club record for all ages!



New county vet record for Craig Rodwell in Discus 32.12m and county chapmp! He managed to juggle senior shot and vets discus which were running at the same time and brought home three silver medals; sen men shot 9.76, sen men discuss 32.10 and vet shot 10.05m.

This is a fabulous event consisiting of four elements - a 75m sprint, 600m run, long jump and howler throw. Rita - Queen of Speed



We are very sad to report that former coach Rita Gordon has passed away. Rita joined Newark Athletic Club in 1999 when she moved to the area. Up until the age of 64 she competed at the highest level, winning gold medals at the National Veterans Championships in the 100 & 200m plus competing at the European Championships in Budapest when she was 63.

Her experience and enthusiasm translated into inspiring her athletes to maximize their potential. Her meticulous eye for good technique had over the years, transformed many of our budding sprinters of all ages, to County & Regional standard.

For three consecutive years she secured Michael Beaumont & John Kelley's places at the English Schools Championships with John knocking off a second in his 100m & 1.3 seconds in his 200m - (JK finished 5th in 21.88 - as a 1st year junior) within a year! She also transformed rookie Michael Smith into English School's material within a season!

Whilst her success was highlighted through her high profile results, her real forte was her undoubted dedication to athletes regardless of their age & ability and her on-going commitment to personal development.

In recognition for her services to athletics in Nottinghamshire, she joined an elite group of sporting heroes, when in January 2008 she was awarded Roll of Honour at the Nottinghamshire Sports Awards evening, a proud moment indeed for her and our club.

In the same year, at the age of 76, we reluctantly allowed Rita to retire! She was hugely missed, not only due to her vast experience and knowledge, but for her incredible rapport with the young athletes who she had given exceptional encouragement and inspiration to.
