Forty six junior club members were amongst 163 athletes from around the county who turned out on a bitterly cold Sunday for the last of the Notts mini league cross country races which was hosted by the club at the Grove.

Newark AC began the day in second place, nearly 60 points from the lead.

Despite all the fantastic performances on the day, it wasn't quite enough for the club to retain the title.



The U11 girls were the season's winning team after they put in a fantastic performance with Emily Crookes placed 2nd in her first race for the club and Amelia Chrispin and Katie Davies placed 4th and 8th respectively, both regulars in the top 8 this season.



Not to be out done, the U11 boys ran a strong race with Angus McCallion coming home 4th, Alex Johnson 9th and Duncan Monaghan 16th.

The U13 girls ran a fabulous race with the first three athletes each giving their performances of the season with Anna Smith 2nd, Abi Green 6th and Imogen Harcombe 7th seeing U13 girls team winners for the season. There was equally fantastic racing from the U13 boys team. Ben Smith was the first Newark U13 athlete home in 2nd place having been placed 1st or 2nd in each of the other four races of the league. Josh McCool and Harvey Hancock were placed 13th and 14th.

A massive well done to the small band of hardy cross country enthusiasts and their supporters who made the long trip to London for the National cross country champs at Parliament Hill.

The weather was pleasant but the underfoot conditions were testing for the youngsters in the early races of the day and by the time the senior men ran in the 10th race of the day the conditions had taken on a Somme like appearance with thick clawing mud all around the $2 \times 6k$ laps making up the 12k course .







Highlight of the day was Cloe Hubbard finishing 38th in the u20 womens race. Aaron Goulding finished a fine 82nd in the u15 boys and his sister Nicole 89th in the u17womens race. Tim Bagguley flogged his way round the mens course to finish 845th out of 2005 finishers which surpassed the previous record number of finishers of 1948 when the championships were held in Newark in 1996. The U13g were the only ones to finish a team for Newark with a commendable 43rd place.

Bronze medal for Ben Lynch in first Youth Bobsleigh competition of the season

Lillehammer, Norway, Sunday 21 December 2014

Congratulations to long time member of Newark AC, Ben Lynch, 15, who won a bronze medal in the first Monobob (single man) race of the season on **Sunday 21st December** in Lillehammer in Norway, which is also where the Youth Olympics will be hosted in February 2016.

After deciding he'd like to give this unusual sport a try, Ben attended a series of tests and assessments which measured strength, speed and agility. He was then asked to train at British Bobsleigh's base at the University of Bath during the summer and he, along with the four-strong GB squad were presented with their race suits at an event at the British Olympic Association on December 6th.

The squad spent a week training in Lillehammer prior to the first competition. The winner came from Romania while the silver medal was taken by fellow GB athlete, Adam Hames from Loughborough. Ben's time for his two runs was 1.58.63 and he reached speeds over 107kmh (66mph). He commented "setting off was always a nervous time but once you get going you have to concentrate so hard you don't have time to be scared. It was a fantastic experience."
